

1970-71 Football Team



The Saint Patrick Football program has had many outstanding individuals throughout history and some very good teams. The 1970-1971 Football season was certainly a season to remember. Under the leadership of head coach Larry Scannell, this talented group of men brought great pride to Saint Patrick High School.

The 1970-71 Saint Patrick Football team dominated their conference, finishing with a 9-1 record in the Suburban Catholic League! Like Basketball, this was the first year playing in the Suburban Catholic Conference after many years in the Chicagoland Prep League. The football team captured the East Division Championship by defeating neighborhood rival Notre Dame. The Shamrocks defeated the West Division Champion, Marmion Military Academy, to claim the Suburban Catholic Conference Championship and finished in the top 10 for state.

Hall of Fame Inductee

Gary Didier '71



Gary Didier was a 4-year football player (1967-1971) at Saint Patrick High School. Didier was a 4-year starter on teams with a combined 31-3-1 record that collectively won three Conference Championships. After he led the freshman team to a 7-0 record and a Conference Championship, Didier was named captain of the sophomore team that finished 8-1. In his junior year, the Shamrocks took home the Conference Championship and finished

with a record of 7-1-1. In Didier's senior year, he was named captain and the Shamrocks, who finished with a 9-1 record, were once again crowned Conference Champions.

Didier was always on the field as he played offense, defense and special teams. With rushing leader Nick Sorrentino unable to play in the team's senior year Conference Championship Game due to an injury, Didier rushed for 103 yards, recovered two fumbles, and shadowed the opponent's All-Conference halfback, limiting him to one touchdown. During his senior year, Didier ran for 700 yards on 135 carries for an average of 5+ yards per carry.

Didier was selected to the SCC All-Conference team and presented with the Golden Helmet Award by the Chicago Tribune as a Prep All Star. He was also selected as All-Area Special Mention and All-State Honorable Mention.

Upon graduation, Didier was recruited by a number of colleges, most notably the Ivy league schools (Yale, Dartmouth, Columbia, Brown, Cornell) and the Army, Navy and Air Force academies. Gary chose to "walk on" to the Northwestern University football team coached by

Alex Agase. He was offered, but declined, a partial football scholarship at the end of his freshman year.

Didier graduated from Northwestern University with a B.S. in Industrial Engineering and Management Science, and earned his MBA from the Kellogg School of Management at Northwestern.

Gary had a successful 40-year career in the financial services industry, primarily working with large banks and investment management companies. He worked for companies around the country, and his family lived in several places including Atlanta, Detroit, Cleveland, San Francisco and Richmond, VA. He's also had the good fortune to manage teams of people located across the U.S. (including Atlanta, Houston, Chicago, NYC, San Francisco, Ft. Lauderdale, Detroit, Cleveland and Richmond), and the world (including Toronto, London, Frankfurt, Hyderabad, Tokyo, Hong Kong, Taipei and Sydney). After logging 2 million air miles and spending 1.5 years worth of nights in hotel rooms, Gary retired in 2016 after serving 10 years as the Chief Technology Officer for Invesco, one of the largest, global, independent investment firms.

Didier says, "It's a tremendous honor and privilege to be inducted into the Shamrock Hall of Fame. I'm very proud and also humbled by St Pat's honoring me in this way. It's also a great pleasure and rare blessing to have played with a three-time champion Hall of Fame team, four Hall of Fame coaches and three teammates who've also been individually inducted into the Hall of Fame. It doesn't get any better than that!"

1970-71 Basketball Team



The Saint Patrick basketball program has had many outstanding individuals throughout its history and some very good teams. The 1970-71 Basketball season was certainly a season to remember. Under the leadership of head coach Max Kurland, the talented

group of young men on the team brought great pride to Saint Patrick High School.

The 70-71 team dominated their conference, finishing 8-1 in the competitive East Suburban Catholic Conference in their first year in the league. The Shamrocks finished the regular season with a record of 26-5, tying the 1959-60 team for the most wins in a season. The 70-71 team won the Saint Patrick Thanksgiving Tournament and finished in 3rd place at the Carbondale Christmas Holiday Tournament. The team captured the East Division Championship by beating Notre Dame twice and breaking their neighborhood rival's win streak. Like the football team, the Basketball team defeated the West Champion, Marmion Military Academy, to claim the Suburban Catholic Conference Championship. The Shamrocks went on to win the Regional and advance to the Sectional Finals before losing to Oak Lawn, the eventual State Runner-Up. During their four years, the players on the '70-'71 team were coached by three hall of fame coaches: Joe Schmidt, Bill Geist and Max Kurland.
